1st Timothy {4:9} This is a faithful saying and worthy of all acceptation. {4:10} For therefore we both labour and suffer reproach, because we trust in the living God, who is the Saviour of all men (people), specially of those that believe. {4:11} These things command and teach.

Romans {3:21} But now the righteousness of God without (outside of) the law is manifested, being witnessed by the law and the prophets; {3:22} Even the righteousness of God which is by faith of Jesus Christ unto all and upon all them that believe.
